REPORTS:

Admin Ross reported The Memorial Day parade will begin at 2 p.m. Sunday at the I.V. School; the village will put flags up on Friday. The water meter project has thirty meters left to install and the meters that are hand plumbed will not be changed out to radio read meters (Speedway, Car Wash). Last reading there were approximately 36-70 errors with 100 meters not reading. The staff will trouble shoot the issues. Ross also reported the village collected \$1,700 in scrap metal from the replacing of the water meters. Several residents have called about increase in their water bills; the new meters increase pressure. The old meters were gummed up and the water readings were not as accurate as the new meters installed now. Blood Drive will be held on June 1 from 3-6 p.m. Farmers Market will be every Thursday starting on June 1 from 4-7 p.m. at Settlers Park. Email billing will work well with the water utility bill system, hopefully Council can vote on this issue soon. There will be an extra charge to use a credit charge for bill pay. Admin Ross reported there will be a pre-construction meeting for the Speedway Drive water loop on Tuesday May 30th. Ross reported the High Hopes Day Care on Davis

Drive will be installing a connection to Clark County sewers this summer; the system on the property was not sufficient to do the job. A service line break occurred on Sunny Brook this week, leak was visible up on the asphalt. Meadowlark has clogged drains and the discharge pipe is blocked. Councilman Hanna asked if a cold patch could be used on Blue Jay before Meadowlark as the road is giving out.

Chief Wilcox reported the approval was given for the Enon Fights Epilepsy 5K Run/Walk on Saturday June 3rd beginning at 10 a.m. The event will follow the same route as the Apple Butter run; Enon Police will maintain traffic control during this event.
